Call for Proposals for the FY2026 RARiS Workshop Program

As part of the Joint-Use / Collaborative Research Program at the Electron and Photon Science Center, RARiS, Tohoku University, we invite proposals for the FY2026 RARiS Workshop Program under the guidelines below. Submitted workshop proposals will be reviewed by the Proposal Review Committee of the Electron and Photon Science Center (scheduled for Friday, February 27, 2026) and will be selected based on academic significance, timing, and other considerations. We welcome a wide range of workshop plans from the user community.

*Guidelines for FY2026 RARiS Workshop Proposals

Please include the following items in your application:

-Workshop title / theme

-Brief description of the theme (approx. 400 Japanese characters or equivalent length in English)

- Names and affiliations of all organizers, and the contact person's address, phone number, and e-mail address

Note: Please ensure that the organizers are not concentrated within a single organization, but are broadly composed of members from multiple institutions. Inclusion of members related to the RARiS is also desirable.

-Requested budget, a brief breakdown of how it will be used, and the basis for the requested amounts

- Notes: The budget may be used for travel expenses only. Travel support depends on the available budget, and there may be cases where financial support cannot be provided.

-Expected format and approximate scale of the workshop

(Example: international workshop; ~5 participants from overseas and ~20 participants from Japan)

-Venue

Note: In principle, workshops should be held at RARiS. If you plan to hold the workshop at another venue, please state the reason.

-Preferred dates for the workshop

-Application deadline and submission address

*Submission by e-mail: February 9, 2026 (Mon) 23:59 (JST), deadline (must arrive by this time)

* Workshop report

A workshop report (approximately one A4 page) should be submitted within one month after the workshop.
